

Bob Mitchell, Coach Bradley Tapped For All-Star Game

Bob Mitchell, All - State AA forward on the Newton County Rams basketball team, has been chosen to play in the GHSA-Atlanta Journal sponsored North - South High School cage game in Atlanta. The game, an annual affair, will be played at Alexander Memorial Coliseum on August 2.

Named as the head coach of the North team, for which Mitchell will play, is T. P. Jones of Headland. Jones' assistant will be Coach Ronald Bradley of Newton County.

Jimmy Hightower of Americus will be the coach of the South Stars in the fray. His assistant will be Billy Dees of Manor High.

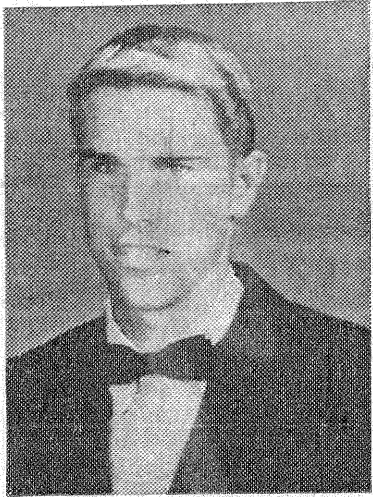
Mitchell's selection marks the second time in the past three years that a Newton Countian has been named to the annual game. The late Billy Dean Rutledge was slated to play for the North in the 1959 game but was the victim of drowning in July preceding the game in early August. Rutledge was also an All-State player at NCHS.

Two 15 - player squads will be announced in next Sunday's Atlanta Constitution - Journal. The two squads this year will have players from all classifications in the state.

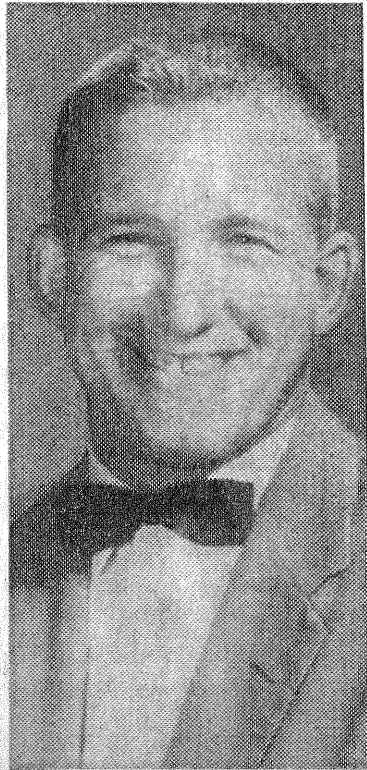
Tom Ewell Talks Book
