BLOODWORTH, GARY	5 11	FORWARD	10	Good shooter and rebounder, needs to improve speed. Should become fine player before he graduates.
CAMPBELL, GRADY	5 8	GUARD	12	Had a steady diet of basketball this summer. Has improved in all phases of the game. Strong outside shooter, good driver, should be All Star candidate by season's end.
CHRISTIAN, TIM	6 1	CENTER	11	Led '63 team in scoring and rebounding, also selected as M.V.P. No apparent weaknesses as he performs his duties with speed and grace with little apparent effort. With 2 seasons remaining, Tim will be a big threat to Newton's individual school records.
HALL, WAYNE	5 11	FORWARD	10	As soon as his inexperience is conquered, should become a terrific player. Wayne is a good shooter, ball handler and puts out a lot of effort. Needs to improve defense and his lack of height is only other noticeable weakness.
HARRIS, STANLEY	6 0	GUARD	11	Many Newton fans compare Stan's style of play to former Ram, Bob Mitchell, he has excellent control of his hands and body, and is a fine shooter. Needs more experience and to improve his defense. With two years left should become outstanding player.
HINTON, EDDIE	6 0	FORWARD	9	Young, inexperienced, but with four years to go could become a fine basketball player.
HINTON, JEFF	5 11	CENTER-FORWARD	11	Excellent rebounder, good speed, good defensive player, needs to improve on ball handling, and needs more experience in order to become a top notch player.
PROSSER, TIM	5 6	GUARD	11	Good jumper, fair speed, fair shooter, needs to become more durable as injuries have handicapped his basketball progress.
RICHARDSON, BOB	5 6½	GUARD	10	Young, inexperienced, but in the next three years could become an outstanding scorer. His shooting ability is handicapped by his lack of size and speed, but with maturity will be a fine player.
RUTLEDGE, J. W.	6 0	FORWARD	11	Another in a long line of Rutledges to perform for the Rams. Good speed, fair ball handler, fair rebounder, needs to improve defense and shooting. With time, experience, and more effort will become a typical "Rutledge".
SMITH, STEVE	5 5	GUARD	10	Good shooter, fair ball handler, but lack of height is hurting Steve. Has three years left in which to improve.
SMITH, TERRY	5 8	FORWARD-GUARD	12	Has been described as the biggest little man that Newton has ever had. Terry is a fine all-round player as he has no weaknesses. Is a tremendous competitor and is voted as one of Newton's all time great defensive players. Definite All Star prospect. Also outstanding baseball player, and had been named to the All-Star Team for the last two seasons.
WILEY, JIM	5 10	FORWARD	11	Good rebounder, fair shooter, fair defense, needs to improve speed. With two years left Jim could become a fine player with hard work and more individual concentration.
