

#### REVIEW OF SENIORS' CAREER

The seniors on the 1964-65 Newton County Rams basketball team have completed one of the most fabled, most talked-about, and most written-about four years in the history of high school basketball in the state of Georgia. Tim Christian, Stan Harris, and J. W. Rutledge have amassed a fabulous won-lost record of 125 wins and only 9 losses during the four-year period from 1961-1965.

The teams on which these three boys have played have won many championships, including three region championships and a state championship. Two straight years they have ended the season with the best record in the state---35-1 in 1964 and 34-1 in 1965, for a 2-year record of 69 wins and only 2 losses. These boys had a winning streak of 42 straight victories before their only loss of this season.

Their home-court record is truly a legend throughout the state.

They helped to keep the perfect record of last years' seniors intact
as they now have won 90 straight in the N.C.H.S. gym.

These three seniors have helped to re-write most of the basketball records at Newton County High School and theirs is a legend that will not be forgotten by basketball fans throughout the state of Georgia.
