#### REVIEW OF SENIORS' CAREER

The final whistle has sounded on the 1972 basketball season, and with it four great athletes have indelibly stamped their accomplishments on the memories of the many Newton Countians whose hearts throb to the beat of a basketball.

The careers of Kevin Price, Neal Dickerson, Donnie Freeman, and Doug White have left many records and exciting accomplishments. Their ability and competitive fire have helped continue the famous Newton County tradition.

This tradition has resulted in an increasing demand for that most scarce Ram product—a ticket to a Newton County home game. As in recent years, the past season saw several more turn-away crowds at the NCHS gym.

The four seniors' last year was an exciting year for Ram followers. The 1972 season was a year in which great play and spirit helped lead the team to a 25-2 season. This was also the season in which the Rams stopped the Forest Park home court winning streak at 64 straight. The Rams were rated as the Number 1 team in Georgia for most of the season. The '72 seniors once again powered their way to the 6AAA championship.

The Newton County fans were so impressed with the class of the '72 team that they decided some special reward should be given. The fans made possible a four-day all expense paid trip to the Kentucky state tournament. It was the first time that a Newton team has made a trip by jet plane.

The basketball future shines bright for Newton County basketball followers. A big share of this brightness was created by the '72 seniors Kevin, Neal, Donnie and Doug.

Kevin and Neal played on teams that won four straight region championships, four invitational championships, and were State AA runner-up in 1970. Donnie and Doug were a part of 2 region championships and two Invitational championships.

During the past four years the Newton County lads have won 96 games while losing only 15. The seniors have never failed to be in the state's "top 10" polls. NCHS has now been rated in the Top Ten category for the last nine consecutive years.

Many Newton Countians will never forget the many accomplishments and records left by the 1972 seniors.
