#### REVIEW OF SENIOR'S FINAL YEAR

The 1975-'76 basketball season goes into the record books as the most fantastic season in the history of George Walton Academy. The team accomplished what every person and team aspires to be -- the best.

The Bulldogs got off to a good start winning 8 of the teams first 10 games. At the Christmas break few people would have dreamed that GWA was through losing for the season.

Seniors Randy Henderson and Todd Whitsitt's leadership, effort, and inspiration helped make the "Dogs" unbeatable during the last 19 games.

GWA hosted the Region 3A North Tournament sporting a twelve game victory streak. In the opener Samuel Elbert Academy slowed the pace down against the Dogs but fell 64-45.

The opening region 3A game at Sparta was a big hurdle. Randy Henderson got the Dogs off to a good start with the opening basket.

Washington Johnson behind fantastic shooting jumped to a 11-2 lead and a 21-10 first quarter margin. With 1:44 left in the second quarter W. J. led 39-20 but at the half the score was 41-26. The Bulldogs trailed 53-42 at the end of the third quarter. GWA managed a 63-63 tie at the buzzer, and went on to a 69-67 win in two overtimes.

In the region championship game the Bulldogs faced Bartow Academy 26-2, and the preseason favorite to win all the marbles. Bartow led 12-11 and 27-20 at the first two stops. Midway of the third quarter Bartow led 36-25 but the main concern was the four fouls that Whitsitt carried. With three minutes left in the game GWA went ahead for the first time 43-42, with 3 seconds on the clock GWA trailed 49-48 but Todd Whitsitt's final shot struck nylon for a 50-49 victory and the 3A championship title.

The state tournament opener at Marshallville was a marathon. Georgia Christian Academy is a big well disciplined team. The Bulldogs had to go three overtimes to subdue the fine team from Valdosta 50-47.

In the state semifinal game GWA faced a fine Robert Toombs team. The Crusaders let 28-20 and 42-33 at the first two stops. With 1:15 left in the Third quarter Toombs led 61-45. The last quarter saw the Bulldogs get red hot and with 3 minutes left in the final quarter the Bulldogs tied the score 64-64. GWA went on to a 74-69 win.

In the state finals the Bulldogs faced Windsor Academy of Macon, a surprise 65-63 winner over Bartow.

The Dogs led Windsor 15-14 and 28-24 at the first two breaks. Late in the third quarter GWA shooted to a 49-40 lead.

The Bulldogs controlled the pace the fourth quarter to win the schools first state championship 65-60.

#### RANDY HENDERSON

Randy had an outstanding season for the Bulldogs. He was the leading rebounder averaging 14.1 rebounds per game. Henderson averaged 16.1 points per game and let the team in field goal percentages with a 48% accuracy mark.

Randy was named to the Class A All State Team, Region 3A All Star Team, and was selected to the North All Star Team.

#### TODD WHITSITT

Todd has a great year for GWA. He led the team in scoring with a 32 point average; in steals with a 2.3 average. in free throw percentage with a 77% accuracy mark, also set the team pace in several other categories.

Todd was named to the Class A All State Team, Region 3A All Star Team, and was selected to the North All Star Team.

Whitsitt was selected most valuable player in the State Tournament, most valuable player in the Region 3A Tournament, most valuable player in the 3 A North Tournament and most valuable player in States SEAIS North-South All Star Game played for the states best seniors.
