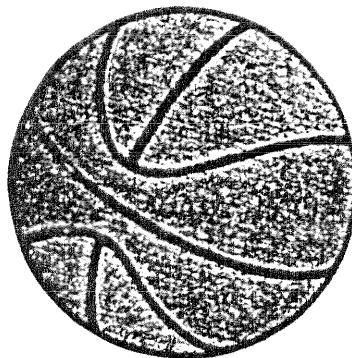

TRIBUTE TO THE SENIORS

The close of the 1990-91 basketball season brings to an end the basketball career at Trinity Christian School of several outstanding athletes. Charles Coleman and Steve Pope have spent their entire school years at Trinity, and were joined several years ago by Rob Jackson. This year, they were joined by Brian Smith and Todd Yates, who chose to complete their senior year at Trinity.

This season brings to a close an outstanding career on the basketball court for Charles Coleman. His record-setting performance of 50 points vs. St. Andrews in the region tournament will never be forgotten by those in attendance. He ends his career with a total of 1,735 points, making him the second-leading scorer in TCS history. His season average of 26.7 ppg. is also second in school's history. Charles has been named to the all-region team the past two seasons. This year he has received virtually every honor available to a basketball player in the area, having been selected to the AA All-State team and the AA All-tournament team. He recently played in the AA-AAA All Star Shootout game and has been selected to play in the N-S All Star game this summer. He has been named to the GISA Team of the Year which will be honored by the Atlanta TipOff Club at its prestigious Naismith Awards Banquet to be held at the World Congress Center in Atlanta.

Rob has been a member of the varsity basketball team at TCS for four seasons, and has made a valuable contribution to the team in many ways.

Steve has been a member of the varsity for four years and this year led the team in rebounding with an average of 14.3 rebounds per game and was the team's second-leading scorer with an average of 16 points per game. He was named to the all region team this year. Steve recently signed a football scholarship to West Georgia College.

Brian joined the team after Christmas, but his athletic ability was much in evidence as he contributed greatly to the '91 Crusaders. He led the team in blocked shots with 33, and was second-leading rebounder with an average of 13 rebounds per game. He also averaged 15 points per game.

Todd became a Crusader as a senior and led his team in steals with a total of 71. He also averaged 7 points per game and contributed much to the Crusaders' success this year.

These outstanding young men have been greatly appreciated during their career, and their accomplishments will long be remembered by their fans.
