



Bradley to coach again

•After a one-year retirement, **Ron Bradley** is returning to the basketball court.

Bradley, the winningest active high school basketball coach in Georgia, will coach his first high school game outside the state. The veteran coach was

recently named the boys basketball coach at Port Saint Joe High School in Florida.

"I had thought something might develop in-state but nothing worked out," Bradley said. "This will be a good opportunity to return to coaching. I am looking forward to the opportunity to work with young people again."

Bradley, who has compiled 1,198 career wins, last coached the boys and girls teams at Piedmont Academy in Monticello for two years after directing the Loganville High School boys team for the three previous seasons. He also coached at George Walton Academy.

"I feel privileged to now have the chance to coach in my sixth decade," Bradley said Wednesday. "Port St. Joe has been successful in athletics and the school has

excellent facilities."
