

Former Newton legendary coach to lead Heritage

Bradley returns to the court after retiring 12 days ago

Ron Bradley has come out of retirement — again. Bradley, who began his coaching career at Newton

High School in 1957 and won a state championship in 1964, was hired as the new head coach of the boys' basketball program at Heritage less than two

weeks ago. Prior to accepting the position, Bradley was the head coach at Greater Atlanta Christian School. It was

the fourth time Bradley has returned to coaching after retiring just as many times.

“We are really looking forward to it,” Bradley said during a phone interview from his home Tuesday evening. “We were blessed to be in (the) position at the right time, and we just love to be around kids.”

Bradley was approached by at least four different schools before agreeing to replace Tony Watkins as the head basketball coach for Heritage. The Patriots were 13-11 this season, and last in Region 8-AAAA, Sub-Region B.
