Danielle O'Reilly, MEDFORD, N.J.

Track and Field

Danielle, a senior at Shawnee High, set a girls' national high school indoor pole vault record when she cleared 13' 5" at a meet at the 168th Street Armory in New York City. She is ranked 16th this year among U.S. women.





Ari Molina, ARLINGTON, VA. **Wrestling-Swimming**

Ari, a junior at Yorktown High who had suffered a broken nose three days earlier, won the National District 145-pound wrestling final, and less than an hour later he swam to a second-place finish in the Virginia AAA state breaststroke final.

Maggie Westfal, NEW CANAAN, CONN. Hockey

Maggie, a junior who plays left defense for New Canaan High, became the state's first high school player (boy or girl) to score 60 goals in a season. She also became the first girl and fourth player to score more than 200 career points (205).





Ronald Bradley, COVINGTON, GA. Basketball

Bradley, 69, basketball coach at Newton High, earned his 925th victory and became the state's alltime winningest boys' high school coach. His teams hold the national record for most consecutive home court wins (129).

Alyssa Lampe, TOMAHAWK, WIS. Wrestling

Alyssa, a sophomore who competes at 103 pounds for Tomahawk High, became the first girl to wrestle in the Wisconsin high school individual meet. She had a 33–12 record this season, including three wins over boys who qualified for the individual meet.





Fred Bousquet, PERPIGNAN, FRANCE Swimming

Bousquet, a senior at Auburn, led the Tigers to their eighth consecutive Southeastern Conference swimming and diving title, with individual victories in the 50- and 100-meter freestyles and the 100 butterfly. He won six titles overall.

Meaghan Cahill, NORTH HAMPTON, N.H. Skiing

Meaghan, a senior at Berwick Academy, won the slalom and giant slalom to lead the Bulldogs to their second New England Prep School Athletic Conference Class C Alpine girls' ski title. She finished the season undefeated in both events.
