TRIBUTE TO THE SENIOR

The final whistle has sounded on the best girls basketball season in the history of George Walton Academy. Stamped indelibly on the minds of Bulldog fans are the accomplishments and spirited effort of their 1976 Bulldog team.

This year's team, led by captain Pam Briscoe, won a school record 15 straight games before losing. In fact, the only two losses of the season were by a total of 4 points.

The defense-dominated team held their opponents to a 27.3 scoring average per game. In 13 games the enemy failed to crack 25 points.

The GWA girls won the championship of the Forsyth Invitational Tournament during the Christmas break. The championship game saw the Bulldogs come from 14 points behind to defeat the host school 32-27.

GWA won the opening 3A North game over Rutledge 50-30. Revenge was gained in the finals by a 38-34 margin over Gatewood Academy.

In the semi-finals of Region 3A, GWA defeated Bartow 47-40. The final night saw the Bulldog Girls win their first Region title ever by a 35-30 score over host John Hancock who was trying to win its fourth straight Region title.

The first game of the state tournament was won in overtime, 24-22 over Westwood Academy. Citizens Christian Academy defeated our girls in the semifinals by a 33-32 score to make the GWA girls' record read 26 wins and only 2 defeats.

Pam's final year saw her gather many honors and awards. She led the team in scoring with a 12.5 average, and was the leading rebounder averaging 11.9 rebounds.

Pam was named to the Region 3A All Star Team for her play during the season. She was named Most Valuable Player for her overall play during the Region meet. Briscoe was named to the Class A All State team, composed of the 10 top players representing 57 schools. She was also named to the North All-Star team.

Many George Walton fans will never forget the many accomplishments and records left by Pam Briscoe and the 1976 Bulldog girls team.
