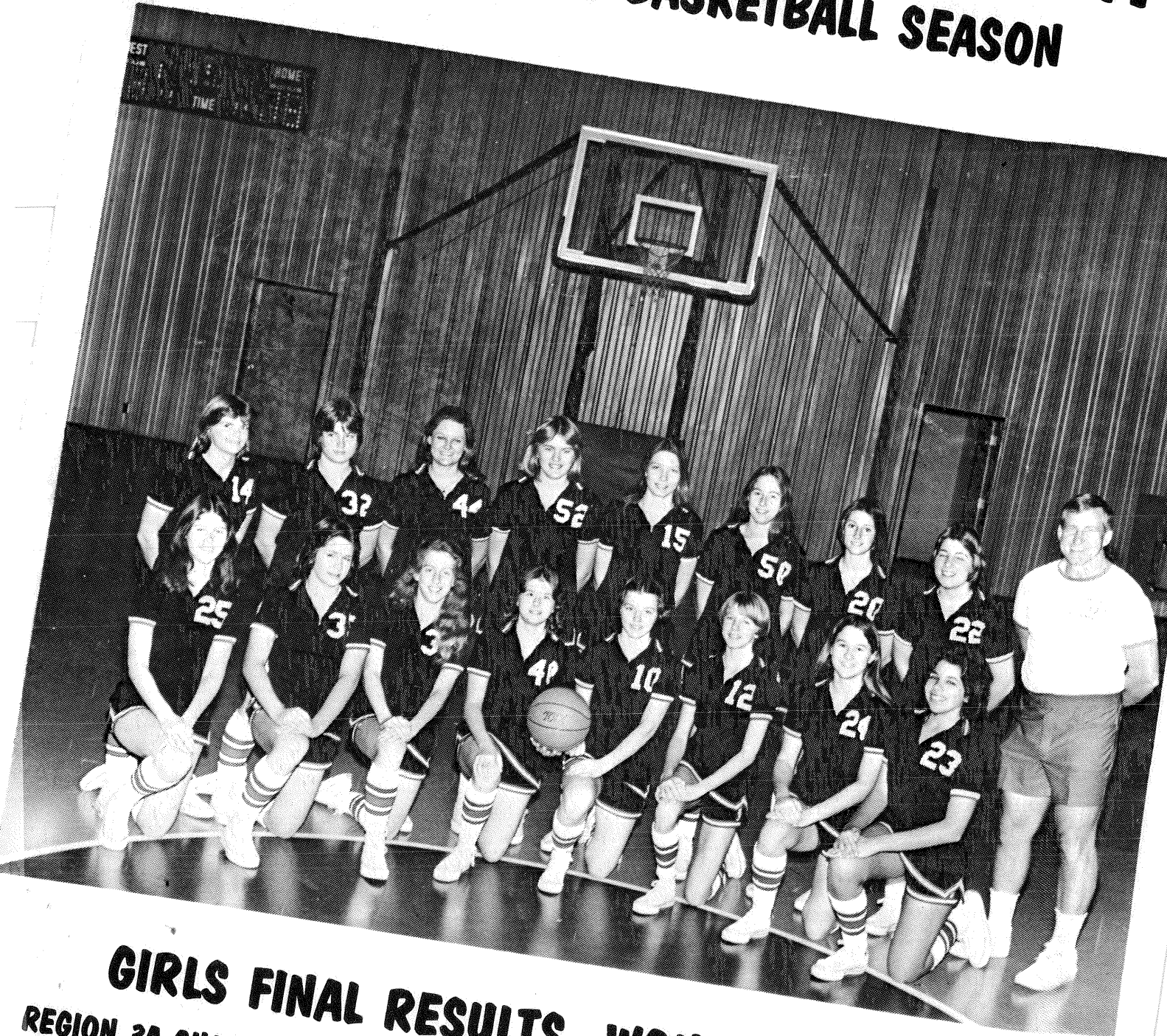

REVIEW OF SENIORS' FINAL YEAR

As the Seniors of the George Walton Academy Lady Bulldogs look back on their high school career, there can be nothing but pride. These girls **have** proven time and again that good things come to those who are willing to pay the price.

Mary Huff, Cheryl Hearn, Pam McDonald, Tammy Harrison, and Sherry McMichael led their team to a 24-5 season record and their third straight trip to the State Tournament. The Bulldog girls rolled up a 50-7 record for the past two years.

The hard work and sacrifice of these young ladies was obvious from the beginning as they rolled up nine straight victories to begin the season before finally losing a heart breaker to Worth Academy in the finals of the GWA Invitational Tournament.

As Tournament time approached, The GWA girls responded to the pressure of Tournament play in championship form. They clearly showed why they dominated 3A North throughout the season. The girls defeated Rutledge 51-32 in the opener and then defeated a strong Gatewood team 45-40 on the Gatewood home floor. To claim the 3A North Championship in the semi-finals of the Region Tournament GWA won their way into the State Tournament with a 63-32 victory over Thomas Jefferson. In the finals, the Lady Bulldogs won their second straight Region Championship with a 43-36 win over John Hancock.

In the first round of the State Tournament GWA defeated Beechwood 42-36. In the Semi-finals GWA fell to Worth Academy 42-29.

Senior Mary Huff was named to the Region 3A All Star Team and was Most Valuable Player in the 3A Tournament. Mary was also chosen to play in the SEAIS North-South Game.

All of the '77 Seniors made many contributions to the tradition of George Walton Academy that won't be forgotten.
