

REVIEW OF SENIORS CAREER

The two Seniors of the 1979-80 Girls Basketball Team of George Walton Academy have a five year record second to none in GWA's history.

Pat Bowick and Kim McCullers have been members of the varsity basket-ball teams for all five years of their high school years. During this time they have been an important part of teams that have won four invitational tournament championships, four region championships and one state runner-up. The teams of which they have been members have participated in the State Tournament five consecutive years - a record that can be tied, but never broken. Their teams have an overall 5 year record of 126 wins and only 19 losses.

As seniors, Pat and Kim led their team through a Cinderella Season - an undefeated regular season (25-0), a region championship, and then on to the State Tournament with a 27-0 record going in as one of the favorites. Two great victories in the quarter-finals and semi-finals of the State Tournament set up the story book finish of an undefeated (29-0) team playing for the state championship! But the clock struck midnight while the Lady Dogs were two points behind. The dream ended with a 29-1 season and a State Finalist trophy to bring home.

Pat and Kim were both named to the All Region Team, All State Team, and the Class A - All State Team. Kim was selected as MVP in the region tournament for the second consecutive year.

They were both selected to play for the North in the North-South All Star Game, and led their team to a 70-67 victory over the favored South team.

Pat and Kim have truly been an inspiration to their teammates. They have earned much respect from their opponents. Their desire and dedication is deeply appreciated and will long be remembered by their friends and associates at George Walton Academy.
