

A REVIEW OF THE SENIORS' CAREER

The 1990 season brings to an end the career of four Trinity Christian School athletes. Rhonda Harden, Lee Haskins, Renee Robertson and Bonnie Smalley spent their entire high school career at TCS. Their efforts have culminated in two excellent years in their junior and senior years.

This year the four seniors helped put together a 24 and 5 record, a region 4AA title and reached the AA State Tournament semi-finals. Their last two years in high school they compiled a 48-10 record and two trips to the state tournament.

Rhonda Harden has just completed her fifth year of basketball at TCS. She was selected to the AA All-Tournament team this year. Rhonda was also selected as the Region 4AA Most Valuable Player and selected to the all-region team.

Lee Haskins is completing her third year on the varsity at Trinity. This year she was selected to the AA All State team and was selected to the 4AA all-region team for the second straight year. Lee set a new school scoring record when she scored 40 points against Cross Keys. Lee has been selected to the South all star team which will play the North team in Milledgeville this summer.

Renee Robertson has played on the TCS varsity for the last five years. Renee was named to the 4AA all-region team for the third consecutive time. She was selected to the AA All-Tournament team as a junior. She has been selected to the South team and will participate in the North-South All Star game in Milledgeville this summer. Renee has played in the last 113 games at TCS.

Bonnie Smalley has been a member of the varsity basketball team for the last four years. She played the defensive post position and was a valuable part of the Crusader program.
