

TRIBUTE TO THE SENIORS

The 1991 season brings to an end the Trinity Christian School career of seniors Kim Ellington and Carol Holmes. The last two years have seen the Lady Crusaders win region championships as TCS won 47 games and lost 10.

Kim has had a record-setting year and has received many honors during her high school career. During the regular season she set a new school record for most points in a game as she scored 41 points. She averaged 21 points and more than 3 steals per game this season. She was named to the all-region team the past two years, and was named to the all-state team this year. She recently played in the AA-AAA All Star Shootout game. Playing with and against the state's best seniors, she was high scorer with 29 points. Kim has been selected to play in the North-South All Star game this summer. She will long be remembered for her exciting style of play.

Carol Holmes, at 6'5", is the tallest player to ever perform for Trinity Christian School. Her shot-blocking and offensive skills were invaluable to the team this season. She also had a record-setting year as she tied the school scoring record with 41 points in one game, and blocked 13 shots in another. She averaged 18 points, 12 rebounds and over 4 blocked shots a game. Carol was named to the All-region team this year, as well as the AA All-tournament team. She also played in the AA-AAA All Star Shootout game. Carol scored 16 points and had 9 blocked shots against AAA's best players. She has been named to participate in the North-South All Star game this summer. She recently became the first female athlete from Laurens County to be named to the Atlanta Tipoff Club's Team of the Year and will be honored at the World Congress Center at the Naismith Awards banquet. Carol has signed a basketball scholarship to Presbyterian College in Clinton, S.C.

Trinity Christian School fans will long remember the exploits of Kim Ellington and Carol Holmes.
